## **EASI Grant Opportunities**

The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) is now accepting applications to distribute *extensive funding* to high need districts and schools across the state based on its federally approved Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) state plan. According to CDE's school designations for the 2021 - 2022 school year, which also apply for the 2022-2023 school year, your school or district could qualify for one of these funding pathways. CDE offers a number of different grant options, through a grant application called EASI, to schools included on this list,

and your eligibility for these funding opportunities could lead to significant new resources for your students, teachers, and administrators. Schools with the following designations qualify:

- Comprehensive Support
  (CS) for lowest 5% OR low
  graduation
- Targeted Support (specific student group(s) identified for intervention)
   Additional Targeted Support

# Ascendium Education Group Awards Grant for Raising Rural Grand

## **Challenge Framework Development**



The Ascendium Education Group announced a grant to Generation Schools Network and the National Rural Education Association to develop a Grand Challenge framework and process to decrease the urban and rural gap between postsecondary credential attainment and workforce entry. GSN and the NREA will work together to engage a small set of national and state rural researchers, policy makers, postsecondary providers, K-12 educators, and community/business partners in the design of a Raising Rural Grand Challenge framework and process that can be rolled out across NREA state affiliates over the next five years, starting with Colorado. Ascendium is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to helping people reach the education and career goals that matter to them. Ascendium invests in initiatives designed to increase the number of students from low-income backgrounds who complete postsecondary degrees, certificates and workforce training programs, with an emphasis on first-generation students, incarcerated adults, rural community members, students of color, and veterans.

## **Colorado Health Foundation Awards Grant**




The Colorado Health Foundation awarded a grant in support of GSN's efforts to bring equity to students throughout Colorado by expanding youth resilience and equity programming in support of social/emotional and mental health. Specially, this support allows GSN to impact a projected 12,500 students by:

- providing Social Emotional Learning programming across 31 schools and districts state-wide,
- increasing local district and staff capacity around SEL through professional development, coaching, a statewide SEL forum and data cycles,
- developing a "Considering Equity" Professional Development offering for leadership teams and a series for school-based teams to increase understanding of equity and race related to Mindset, Structures, Practices, and Policies in schools.
