- HS *Healthy Relationships*: During this unit, students will explore five key practices of healthy relationships: self-compassion, empathy, trust, effective communication, and consent.
- HS Effective Communication for Healthy Relationships: During this unit, students will be asked to explore effective communication, which is the ability to calmly and clearly communicate a message.
- *RE-RELEASED* HS Growth Mindset: By engaging in this unit, students will increase their understanding of the significance of a growth mindset, explore the malleability of the brain, brainstorm ways to nurture a growth mindset, and practice responding to both feedback and failure.
- MS Mindfulness: Mindfulness, for the purpose of this unit, will be defined as a nonjudgmental, non-elaborative awareness of the present moment; an awareness that allows for acknowledgment and acceptance of feelings, thoughts, and sensations as they arise. - HS Coping with Crisis: During this unit, students will explore potential short- and long-term effects of a crisis, discuss recovery strategies, consider common reactions to internal and external crises, and brainstorm recovery activities that can be implemented after a troubling event.
